Charitable Bequests

A Charitable Bequest is a gift arranged as part of your Will, which will be directed to the charity or charities of your choice after your lifetime. When you include a bequest in your will for a charity, such as Watershed Watch Salmon Society, you have options for specifying your gift:

1. You can choose to donate the residue of your Estate in its entirety or as a percentage. The residue is what remains after taxes, administrative expenses and beneficiary commitments have been fulfilled.
2. You can indicate a specific amount.

Additionally, making a bequest provides you with a tax receipt for the full donation amount, which can be claimed on your final tax return.

Watershed Watch Salmon Society recommends that you consult with a legal advisor when planning your Will. A lawyer or other professional will assist with determining the wording of your Will.

To ensure your bequest is fulfilled, we recommend designating your gift as a general donation or directing it towards the area of greatest need. Binding obligations as to their use for a specific program or activity could potentially reduce Watershed Watch's ability to honor the intended legacy if those programs or activities are not in place when the gift becomes effective.
